At the Red River Children's Advocacy Center, we believe that by encouraging open, honest, and safe conversations, we can help kids feel protected, heard, and supported.



Let's Talk About Safety

On a separate piece of paper, write the names of 5 adults who you trust and can talk to if you feel worried, scared or sad!

Spark a Conversation

Ask your child the questions below to start meaningful conversations about safety, trust, and confidence. Starting small conversations now can build trust and confidence that lasts a lifetime:

- What makes someone a trusted adult?
- If you were at school and felt scared, who could you talk to?
- What does it feel like when something doesn't seem right?
- What's the difference between a safe secret and an unsafe secret?
- What does "standing up for yourself" look like?

It Takes a Village
